



## WHAT WE ARE DOING TO KEEP YOU SAFE IN 2021!

We realise this might seem a little daunting to some people, so we want to reassure you that we will still be able to have an awesome festival. To help explain how the festival will run, we've listed some of the key measures we are implementing below.

- **Track and Trace** - we are required to have contact details for everyone on site across the festival to assist with Track and Trace, should this be necessary. Some of you who purchased your tickets more than a few weeks ago will have received an email from our ticketing suppliers, requesting you to create an account and list the names of your guests. PLEASE DO THIS!
- **Lateral Flow tests** - We will be requiring EVERYONE on site (artists/traders/staff included) to provide proof of a negative lateral flow test result prior to entering the festival. This test must have been taken within 24 hours of arriving at the site. If you do not already have a stock of lateral flow tests, you can order these for free [here](#) from the NHS. These will NOT be provided at the festival and if you do not have a test, you will not be permitted to attend the festival.
- **Social Distancing** - The current social distancing guidelines advise staying more than 2m from anyone not in your "bubble" and this rule will be in place at the festival too.
- **Groups of 30 people** - Currently, no more than 30 people are permitted to meet outside, so we will be limiting group sizes to a maximum of 30 people whilst on site at the festival too (we still think this is a pretty decent number of people to hang out with for a weekend anyway!). We will be marking areas (pods) on the ground where you can gather, to ensure an appropriate distance from other groups.
- **Eating & Drinking** - As per the current guidelines, it is necessary to be seated when eating and drinking. You will be able to go to the bar and food concessions as usual, but will need to return to a seat/ground before consuming please. We will be providing reusable cups for you to keep throughout the weekend, as in 2019. These will be charged at £1 but we regret we cannot take these back at the end of the festival (but they do make amazing picnic cups and mementos!)

- **Sanitation** - We will be providing more toilets than necessary and we will have an attendant on site, ensuring these are kept clean. Every single toilet on the site has a hand sanitiser unit in it and we will be providing additional dispensers around the site as well. Please use these!
- **Queuing** - We will be setting up one way systems around each of the bars and food concessions on site. Please remember your social distancing when queuing in these areas or anywhere else.
- **Cashless** - To cut down on lots of people handling cash, we have decided to make the festival entirely cashless for 2021. All shops/bars/food concessions will be accepting card payments only.
- **Meet & Greets** - We will be offering meet & greets with the artists who are keen to do this, however no personal contact will be permitted and you will need to stay a safe distance from them. We have rigged up something pretty cool to make your photos look epic anyway! Please note that these will be at the discretion of the artists themselves.
- **Line-Dancing** - This was one of the most EPIC parts of the 2019 festival so we cannot possibly lose this. As a result, we shall be hosting this from the Main Stage now, to ensure everyone has plenty of space to spread out and dance Covid-safely (I can't guarantee the safety of anyone's dancing other than that!!)
- **Space** - As those of you who attended in 2019 know, we are so fortunate and have a huge site. We will be making the festival arena a little larger, to accommodate social distancing. If you don't want to be near anyone else, you really don't have to be!
- **"Covid Cowboys"** - We understand that some people might find it difficult to remember all these guidelines after they've had a couple of moonshines, so we will have some "Covid Cowboys" doing the rounds of the festival to give gentle reminders. PLEASE be kind to them, they are just doing their jobs and helping keep everyone safe. (n.b. there maybe some cowgirls too, but "Covid Cowpeople" just doesn't have the same ring.....!)

- Please note that implementing these measures is the reason that we are able to continue with the festival this year and they form part of our licensing criteria in terms of keeping our audience safe. It is therefore absolutely imperative that they are adhered to with the best of our collective abilities. Anyone who is repeatedly unable to abide by these may be asked to leave the festival with no refunds offered.

More than anyone, we appreciate that this isn't what we were hoping for, but we know we can host a safe event and all still have an awesome time. We thank you all so much, in advance, for supporting us and sticking by the rules and helping us make Tennessee Fields Festival 2021 into a pretty special memory!
